Critical Thinking Defined What is it? • A process of using logic and reasoning to fully understand a topic from multiple perspectives • Typically an exchange of questions and answers (Although it can be done individually) What does it do? • Allows for more fact-based discussion, aiding the participants in exposing and removing bias/opinions
